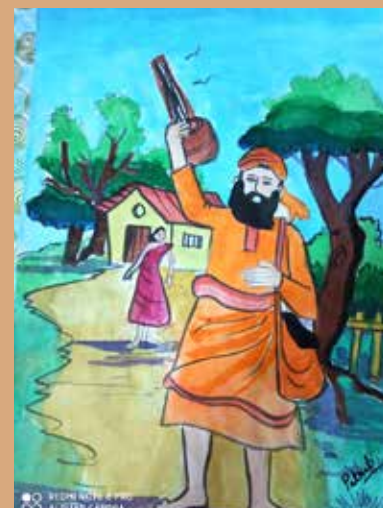
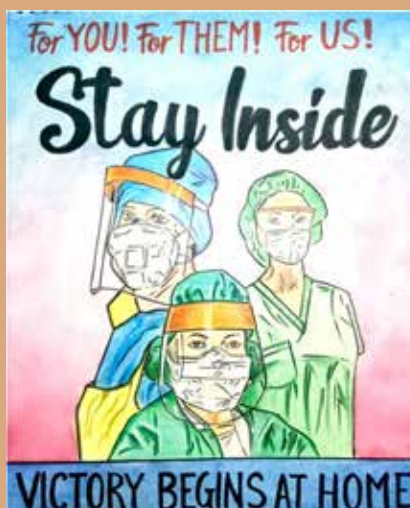


# POSTER & E-CARD Making Activity

didn't revise the lessons in the morning.

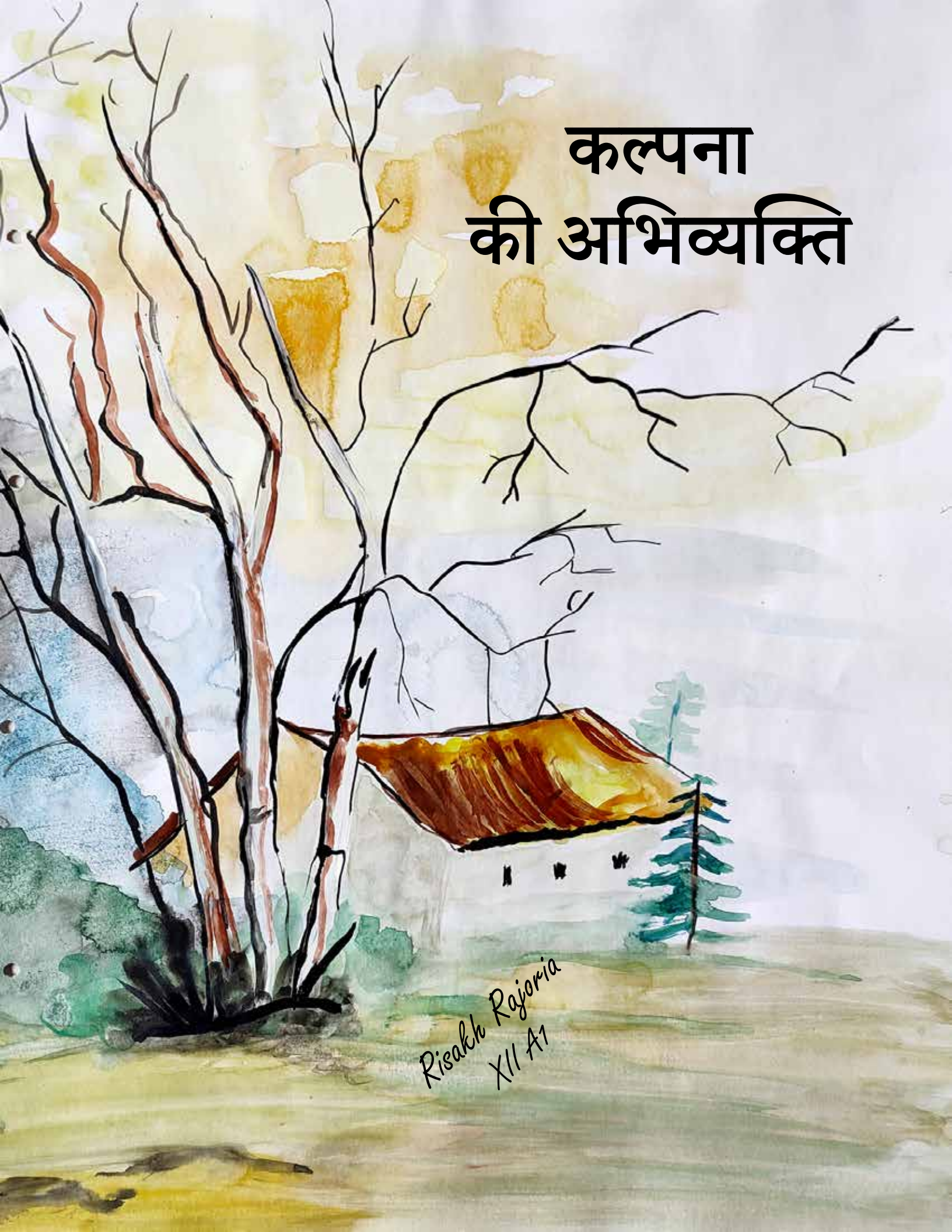

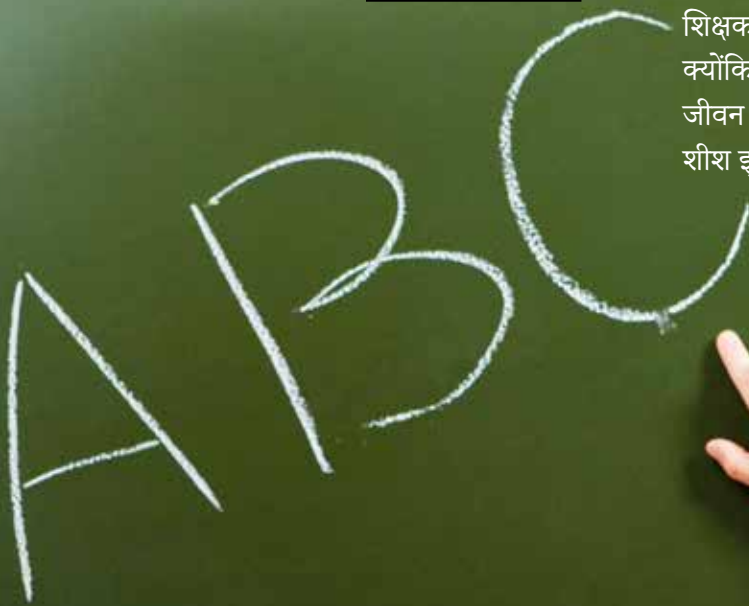

# प्रधानाचार्या का जन्मदिन

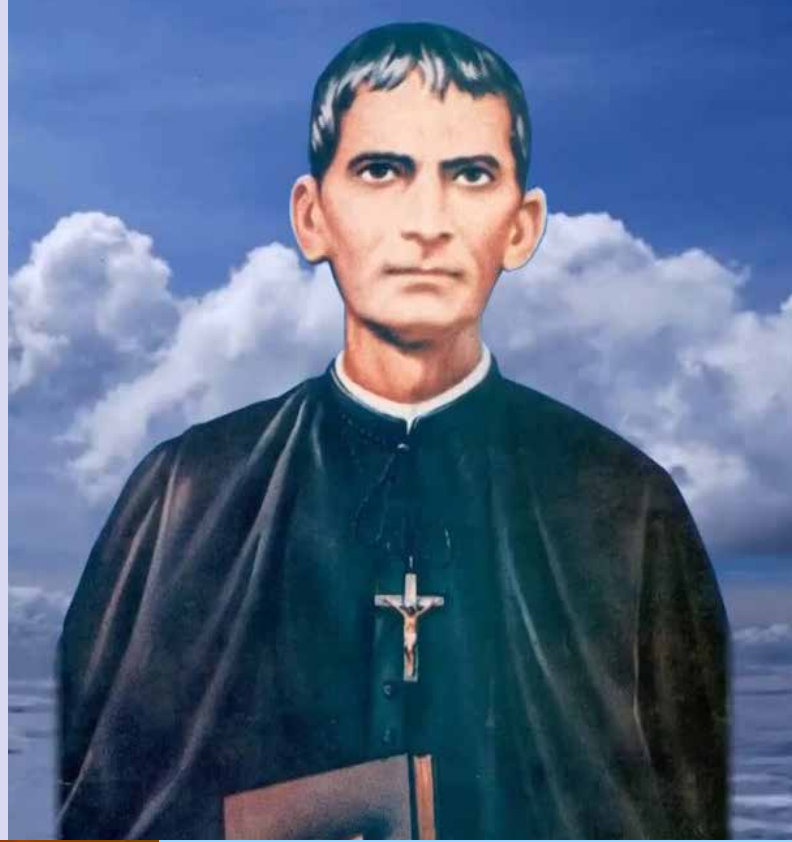

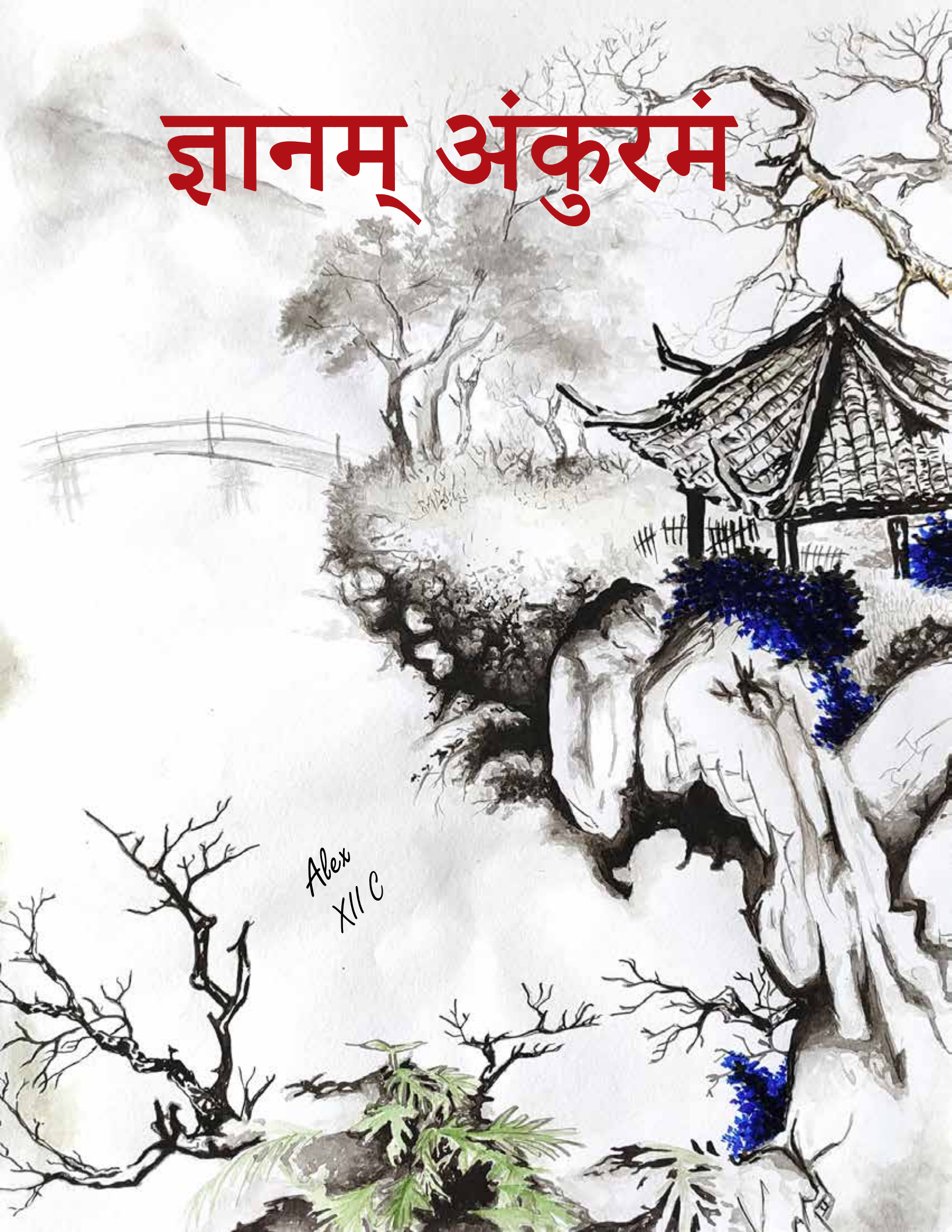

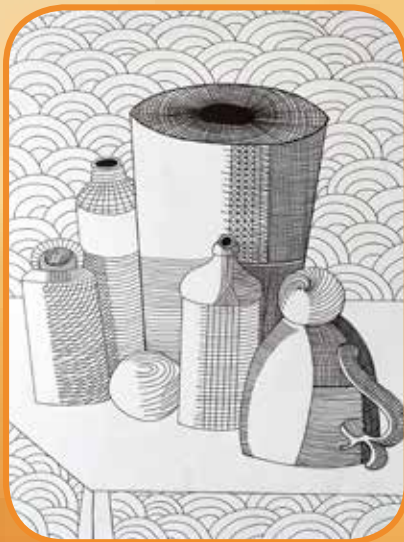
