Schools have gone one step ahead by providing Lecture Capturing Facility so that the students can have access to the Classroom transaction at home or on the go. This technology that brings the classrooms to a student's home, makes learning easier and accessible to every student at his own pace.

Laboratories

Computer Laboratory:

It is very well equipped with desktops, interconnected in a Local Area Network with a central server system. The campus is Wi-Fi enabled. Unique login IDs have been issued to students and the faculty for access. It has a full-time system administrator. Students make effective use of this lab in planning of their lessons and nurture technical skills.



Science Laboratories:

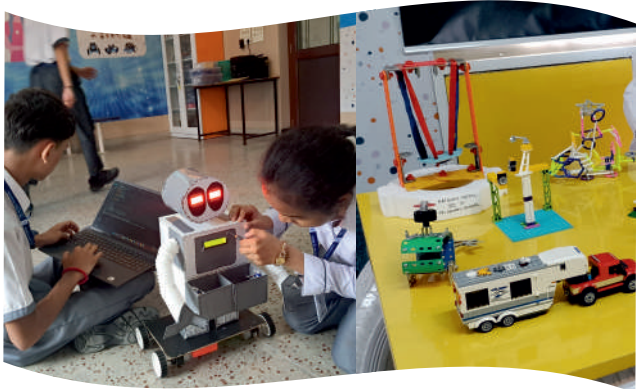
The Physics, Chemistry and Biology labs provide an opportunity to bring theory into practice. They are fully equipped with required equipment. Students get a first-hand learning experience by performing various experiments on their own. Students are made to use the models and understand different scientific theories and concepts.





Atal Tinkering Lab (ATL)

It is solely dedicated to shape the young minds and their ideas while understanding the concepts of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) through do-it- yourself (DIY) kits. The idea is to provide them the (DIY) kits on latest technologies like 3D Printers, Robotics, Internet of things (IOT), Miniaturized electronics, open source microcontroller boards, sensors etc. This boosts confidence and motivates young minds to learn and explore being a scientist and technical experts. We promise you that the practical application would help the students learn with a lot more clarity and gain experience for the future.

Satarang – Modern Auditorium:

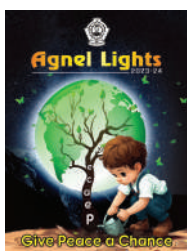

FR.AGNEI BALBHAVAN

Fr Agnel Balbhawan is run by Agnel Charities (Agnel Seva Sangh) Delhi, a registered Society.

This Society was founded by Fr. C. Rodrigues, a patriot and a freedom fighter from Goa where he founded the Religious Society, known as the Society of Pilar in the year 1939.

In the year 2000 a Home for Children - Fr. Agnel Balbhawan at Greater Noida, U.P - was started;

The Fr.Agnel Balbhawan in Greater Noida is an addition to the already existing homes in Mumbai, Navi Mumbai, Pune and Goa where poor and under privilege children from all over the country from different ethnic groups and religions, races and languages are welcomed, cared, sheltered and are given a new experience of love, of belongingness, of the power to be what every child wants to be - a man or a woman of one's dreams.



The children of Fr.Agnel Balbhawan come from different parts of the country - from the North and extreme North-East of India to the extreme South and West, the other children are individuals - poor, orphans and destitute. They live side by side making it possible to all of them to develop together into contributing citizens of our Country. At present there are 250 children.





The Balbhawan has 8 homes, each to house 16 children (boys & girls) of different ages (4 years to 10) under the care of a Mother. It has a common kitchen and dining facilities managed by experienced personnel. Children attend regular school at Fr. Agnel School within the campus which is also open to the residents of Greater Noida and Noida thus giving an opportunity for the Balbhawan children to compete and shine. At the age of 10 they go to the boys and girls Hostels (within the same campus) yet keeping in contact with their own Home. Children are cared, educated and trained until they can stand on their own.
